

Application Procedures for Applicants Who Passed the 2027 Embassy-Recommended MEXT Scholarship First Screening

Contact Period with Our University

Embassy-Recommended MEXT Scholarship Applicants:

July 1 (Wed) – September 1 (Thu), 2026 (JST)

Applicants who have passed the First Screening for the **2027 Embassy-Recommended Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship** and wish to enroll in one of the following programs at the **Graduate School of Veterinary Medicine and Life Science, Nippon Veterinary and Life Science University (NVLU)**, should follow the procedures below:

Eligible Programs:

- Doctoral Course in Veterinary Medicine
- Doctoral Course in Veterinary Nursing and Technology
- Doctoral Course in Applied Life Science

Please note:

The following programs **do not accept research students** and **are not eligible for this application process:**

- Master's Course in Veterinary Nursing and Technology
- Master's Course in Applied Life Science

2. Contact Our University and Submit Required Documents

- Desired academic advisor
- Desired enrollment date

2) Certificate of First Screening Pass

Please **send the original “Certificate of First Screening Pass”** issued by the Japanese Embassy/Consulate to our university **without fail**.

3) Complete Set of Documents Returned from the Embassy

(These documents must bear the confirmation seal of the Embassy/Consulate and have been returned to you.)

Submit the full set, including:

1. Application Form
2. Fields of Study and Research Plan
3. Academic transcript(s) from the university attended
 - *Applicants who have completed or are enrolled in graduate school must submit transcripts from both undergraduate and graduate programs.*
4. Certificate of graduation (or expected graduation) or degree certificate
 - *Applicants who have completed or are enrolled in graduate school must submit both their undergraduate graduation certificate and graduate completion (or expected completion) certificate.*
5. Letter of recommendation from the president/dean or academic advisor at the current or last university attended
6. Medical certificate
7. Abstract of thesis (only if submitted to the Embassy)
8. Language proficiency certificate (only if submitted to the Embassy)
9. Letter of recommendation from employer/supervisor (only if submitted to the Embassy)

Application Deadline

Embassy-Recommended MEXT Scholarship Applicants:

Must arrive by Thursday, September 1, 2026 (JST)

Applications received after the deadline will not be accepted.

After submission, you may be contacted directly by your selected academic advisor.

Such contact does not constitute a guarantee of acceptance.

3. Notification of Provisional Acceptance

Our university will notify applicants **by Thursday, September 24, 2026 (JST)**.

We cannot respond to inquiries regarding the selection results before the official notification date.
